In case of persistent neglect by a trustee of his duties such as towards the Trust. 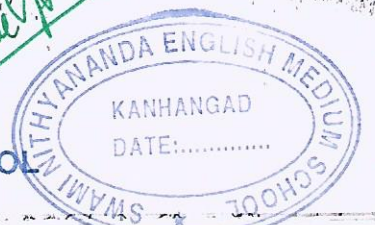

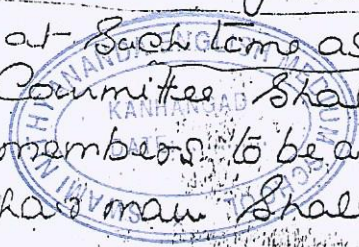

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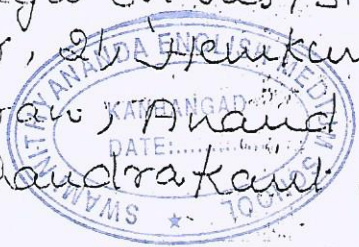
